



List of species which DOS members should report all breeding records because:

1. Site could be designated as a Local Wildlife Site (LWS) because of the presence of a rare species (less than 20 pairs in county or less than 50 pairs in fewer than 10 locations)
2. Site could be designated as a LWS because of the presence of important declining species in the county (not already covered by 1 above)
3. Site could be designated as a LWS because of presence of 3+ pairs of a breeding wader species or 8+ pairs of breeding waders collectively (only applies to Lapwing, Curlew, redshank and Snipe)
4. Schedule 1 species that have to be considered in planning applications
5. Species that would warrant woodland being entered into an Agri-environment scheme application
6. Species that would warrant farmland being entered into an Agri-environment scheme application

In additional breeding records for all species not previously recorded breeding in the county would count under category one. Species likely to breed in the future include Bittern, Little Egret, Red Kite and Herring Gull.
